

The Jackson State Community College Foundation is managed by the Office of Institutional Advancement (OIA). One of the primary purposes of the OIA is to facilitate and record philanthropic giving to Jackson State Community College through the foundation.

The Jackson State Community College Foundation was established in 1977 as a 501 (c) (3) not-for-profit corporation chartered by the state of Tennessee to receive, hold, care for, invest in, and operate with all of the income and/or principal it receives in gifts, purchases, and bequests for the promotion of education and educators, literacy, recreational, artistic, and other activities at Jackson State Community College.


THE ISSUE JSCC loses hundreds of students per semester.


